Assist Education Department administrative staff with Summer Arts Camp programming and supervision. Work with classroom teachers to guide learning and classroom management.

Duties: Assist with Littlest Actors and Littlest Artists camp, Young Actors and Young Artist camp, Specialty camp, and Broadway Actors camp programs

- Maintain a clean and organized classroom/rehearsal space
- Assist with classroom management and student supervision
- Work with small groups of children
- Prepare and collect supplies for the class
- Work with Wardrobe and Set Associate, Stage Manager Apprentice and staff to create and organize costumes, sets, scripts, and props
- Assist in keeping classroom spaces clean and orderly
- Take attendance and notify staff of absences (may be asked to stand-in for missing students roles). Assist with sign in/out
- Walk before and after care campers to and from their camp site
- Ambassadors may be asked to assist with other production or administrative tasks as needed
