## Program Information

- Due to the limited number of spaces available, not all applicants will be accepted
- Applicants must commit to attending monthly meetings
- Monthly meetings on the second Thursday of each month from 4:30 - 6:00 PM (pending holidays)
- Teens must dedicate a minimum of **five hours** each month in volunteer service with the Center
- Only complete applications will be reviewed

**Age requirement:** 14-18 years old

**Reports to:** Education Department

**Term:** Fall 2018 – Spring 2019

Assist Education Department administrative staff with all academic school-year programming and supervision. Work with classroom teachers to guide learning and classroom management. Be a part of the special events team during openings, education events, and fundraisers.

**Duties:** Assist the Art and Culture Center/Hollywood with academic school-year activities.

- Participate in workshops, discussions and events
- Assist with classroom activity and student supervision
- Work with staff to create and organize costumes, sets, scripts, and props
- Maintain a clean and organized classroom/rehearsal space
- Greet guests during events and fundraisers
- Take demographics during events and fundraisers
- Assist with sign in/out
- Ambassadors may be asked to assist with other production or administrative tasks as needed
